"The Sandusky family is disappointed, though not surprised, that Matt has chosen to continue to fabricate a story, this time for a nationally released "documentary." The "documentary" is a prime example of how those who have done wrong and have the most to hide, choose to disguise their motives and actions. Matt cannot hide the facts he moved in with Dottie and Jerry for almost a year in his mid 30's, even knowing there were allegations, left his kids with Jerry alone many times, arranged for and brought his children to our home after Jerry was on house arrest, testified favorably for him at grand jury, stated in Sports Illustrated how positive it was for him to live with us and be our son, and now, all of a sudden have this revelation of sexual abuse, leading to easily acquired financial gain, attention, and sympathy. It is sad to witness what could be a worthy cause represented in such a devious manner.

Because Dottie has already seen the film (in which, among other things, Matt expresses a desire to connect with our family), she is willing to appear with Matt on an appropriate media outlet to discuss his public statements in a substantive manner Since we assume that Matt will be unwilling or unable to participate in such a forum, the family will have no further comment at this time, and refers to its previous statement released after Matt's very telling interview with Oprah Winfrey and to Dottie's heavily-edited opinion piece in this week's Patriot News."
